1. APPLICATION FOR TURKISH ID CARD

Application Requirements:

- 1. It is obligatory to make an appointment on www.konsolosluk.gov.tr.
- 2. In-person application with an appointment is required for those who are over 18 years old.
- 3. Those between the ages of 15-18 have to apply in person with their mother or father or legal guardian, by getting an appointment.
- 4. For those who are under 15 years old, mother or father can apply in person with an appointment. In case of divorce, only the person who has custody of the child can apply for Turkish ID on behalf of the child.

Applications via mail are not accepted.

Required documents:

- 1. Application form (Encl.)
- 2. Old Turkish ID (nüfus cüzdanı) (If applicable.)
 - a) If lost, it is obligatory to submit either a Turkish Marriage Book (uluslararası aile cüzdanı) or a passport or a driver's license.
 - b) If photo of the old Turkish ID is not similar to your current look or you have not had any Turkish ID with a photo on it, you must bring additional IDs with current photo of you.
- 3. 1 biometric photo (2*2), taken in the last 6 months.
- 4. ID of the custody holder, along with its photocopy if the applicant is under 18.
- 5. Another ID with photo for the applicants between the ages of 15-18

Fee:

Turkish ID fee: \$9,50 in cash

Application due to loss of new Turkish ID: \$13,90

Additional information:

- 1. Application fee can only be paid in cash. Personal and company checks are not accepted.
- 2. For those who are under 15, there will be no photos on the IDs. However, upon request, it is possible to add photo of the child. Those who are between the ages of 15-18 have to apply in person with their mother or father or legal guardian.
- 3. Those who are under 15 shall not give biometric data (fingerprint, etc.)

Important information:

Turkish IDs cannot be issued upon application. Once you apply, you may only demand a
temporary ID. Your new Turkish ID will be mailed to our Consulate General, you must either
pick up your new Turkish ID in person by getting an appointment or can give a written consent
upon your application to let someone else to get pick up ID on your behalf.
